From one term, we transition straight into the next. Hopefully you received the emailed copy of your child's Report Card and had a chance to reflect on this past term with your child(ren). Report discussions are a great opportunity to reflect on where we are now, both academically and behaviorally, and where we want, or are expected to be, at the end of this year. Once we've established this, then we identify achievable goals or strategies that will fill in the "gap" and find an accountability mechanism that will aide us in getting there! In the last week or two of this past term, students reflected on their goals from term two, and made new ones for the last trimester. Feel free to discuss your child's goal with them, and ask them how they plan to achieve it.

Tomorrow is our School Spelling Bee and Thursday is the Quad Bee at Credo Elementary in BC. Four grade 7 students and two grade 8 students will be participating in the School Bee. A group of 6 students (2 from each grade from 5-7) will be participating in the quad bee. This year will be the first time that the Bee is done as a group event as opposed to an individual event.

This term will be organizing our Bible Lessons into a discussion format. One student will be required to write an essay to present, while the rest of the class will need to answer various questions that are related to the discussion. Each student needs to come with a prepared question.

This week's memory verse, Eph 2:4-10, is quite lengthy. We have already been reciting it in class. Students are advised not to leave learning it to Thursday evening!

We are scheduled to begin reading our next novel very soon: **The Hobbit**. Each chapter averages to about 10 pages of reading. Scheduled reading times of about 10-15 minutes a day will ensure your child keeps up with the reading. Each chapter will follow with a short quiz.


