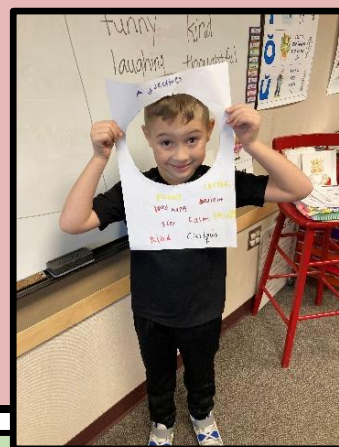

Words are listed below for practicing at home.
