"Thank the Lord and come with praise; songs of jubilation raise..." "for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure."

The above reflects and expresses the joy that emanated from the Jews as they returned back to Jerusalem after the 70 years of captivity. We rejoiced with them and pondered over the fact that if you were born just before the captivity, you would be a grandparent returning with your children and grandchildren! Imagine that!

The concepts in our Bible lessons have helped us focus on God's teachings concerning daily living in His service. This has provided the all-encompassing umbrella under which we work. We've seen two themes of Scripture weave itself through every Bible lesson this year: the covenant faithfulness of the Lord - be it in mercy or in wrath; and, the struggle between the seed of the serpent and the seed of the woman. Throughout our Bible lessons, we've seen that the Lord is not interested in the outward show of righteousness; consequently, we can't earn God's favor through a works righteousness. Through all our lessons here at school, God has been busy removing hearts of stone, and replacing them with hearts of flesh that are pliable to accepting God's law, and where the Holy Spirit may dwell unhindered. (Ezek 11:19 & Heb 8:10). The Holy Spirit awakens in us God's insurmountable love, grace and mercy and causes us to respond the same way Calvin did: "I offer my heart to Thee O Lord promptly and sincerely."

I'm thankful for the hard work and diligent attitudes present in the grade 7/8 classroom. It's a clear indication and manifestation of the Holy Spirit's work amongst us. It's the joyful blessing and fruit of Reformed Education.

May the Lord continue to bless the Covenant Education of our dear children.
