We began our Church History lessons this past week examining the various aspects of the church, the bride of Christ. We learnt that Adam and Eve formed the first church, and when the first worship service was most likely conducted: "At that time people began to call on the name of the LORD." Gen 4:26. When asking Peter who Jesus was, Peter confesses that Jesus was the Son of the living God, and it's on this confession of Peter that the LORD builds His Church. We saw that the New Testament church began at Pentecost: 3000 people were added to the church, and so the church grew daily. May the Lord bless our History lessons as we grow in our love for Him and His bride.

This past Friday we had our first Bible discussion. Studying God's Word formally is exciting. Students need to come prepared to the discussion with a question from either the Bible chapter, or the discussion paper. They also need to answer the Bible questions on the discussion paper, except for those who are presenting an essay on the Bible chapter! This week Wade, Dylan and Jessie will be writing and presenting an essay to introduce on Acts 2: Christ baptizes His own with the Holy Spirit. All students need to ensure they have a question on this chapter and topic for this coming Friday. Please prompt your child they have this ready as they will be graded on their participation.
