I enjoyed talking with you all at conferences last week. It is wonderful to work together with you in teaching your child to read and write.

First grade parents: I am so pleased with the students' growth in reading! Our decodable books come home two nights in a row because reading the books several times moves students from decoding/sounding out to automaticity which is key in learning to read. If your child has mastered reading the decodable book fluently the first night, then they may read a different book to you the second night and you can fill that book in on their reading log.
