

In some cases, students have settled into a very relaxed attitude about reading as they do not have any ACC test results. Our recent Aimsweb test highlights the importance of regular sustained reading. It's highly evident in the test diagnostics that some students are too relaxed about the importance of sustained reading. I have reminded students frequently that leaving reading ACC books to the end of the term is asking for trouble!
