

We have been enjoying reading Frog and Toad stories in both classes and have been working hard at writing our narrative stories.

The first graders are doing a great job reading their decodable books. This past week we were talking about how they are reading so well that their books have gotten easy! I assured the students that the books are about to get more difficult as the next decodables include the new concepts we are learning: vowel, consonant, silent e and vowel teams.
