# **Cornerstone Christian School Health Checklist**



Parents are to perform health screening and check for signs of illness of their children prior to leaving the house. Students are expected to stay home if they have any of these symptoms. Each day the Parent shall review the following questions:

- Does your student have any of the following <u>symptoms that</u> are not caused by another condition?
  - + Fever (100.4 F) or chills
  - + Cough
  - → Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
  - + Unusual fatigue
  - + Muscle or body aches
  - + Headache
  - + Recent loss of taste or smell
  - + Sore throat
  - + Congestion or runny nose
  - → Nausea or vomiting
  - + Diarrhea
- Has your student been in close contact with anyone with confirmed COVID-19?
- Has your student had a positive COVID-19 test for active virus in the past 10 days?
